

Brunswick High School
National Honor Society Membership Contract, 2018-2019

In order to maintain your NHS Membership with the Brunswick High School chapter, you must:

- Maintain a 3.5 weighted grade point average. If your weighted GPA falls below 3.5, you will be given a one semester probationary period to meet this requirement.
- Conduct yourself in a manner consistent with high standards of personal conduct including all guidelines of the NHS discipline policy.
- No major disciplinary infractions, such as referrals or academic dishonesty.
- Complete and present appropriate documentation for at least 20 hours of community service (10 per semester, beginning with the fall 2018 semester). At least 5 hours per semester, 10 hours per year, must be from NHS-sponsored activities.
- Attend at least 75% (7/9) of the pre-scheduled NHS meetings. Notify the advisor if you are to miss an NHS meeting or scheduled volunteer opportunity..
- Participate in an NHS fundraising activity and at least 1 NHS service activity per semester (this does not include the induction ceremony).
- Submit a NHS log sheet to the advisor on the following dates:
 - First semester: January 5
 - Second Semester: May 15
- Have a log sheet available at every NHS meeting for the Leadership Team to check service hours.
- Check NHS website (brunswicknhs.weebly.com) weekly, follow up on Twitter (@NHS_Brunswick), check your email, and sign-up for Remind.
- Read the revised Brunswick High School Chapter Bylaws.

Membership Fee:

The Brunswick High School Chapter of the National Honor Society is requiring a \$20 membership fee. This fee will be used to help pay for NHS stoles for seniors, induction pins for new members, and chapter fees and expenses. Please be aware that this fee may not cover the entire cost of the NHS graduation stole.
